- It is no longer required but strongly recommended for educators and families to continue wearing masks at the centre.
- Effective March 28, 2022 UDC will no longer be separating the children into two cohorts.
- Daily screening occurs through a questionnaire sent via text each morning.
- Keep children at home when new symptoms arise and when ill
- If a new onset of symptoms becomes present during the day care day you will be called to pick up your child within 30 minutes. You will receive a Symptom Documentation form upon arrival

- Individuals with symptoms should follow public health recommendations for testing and/or isolation (right now two negative tests 24 hours apart)
- When absent you must check in with the Executive Director, Assistant Director, or Centre Supervisor before returning
- Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 should follow public health recommendations for isolation
- Isolation for COVID-19 is still advised:
 - People with symptoms should stay home and isolate for five days after symptoms

- start, until they have no fever and other symptoms have improved over the past 24 hours
- Individuals who have tested positive but do not develop symptoms should isolate for five days from the date of the test
- Individuals should wear a well-fitted, well-made mask if they have contact with other people while they are ill, when their isolation is finished, for 10 days after the onset of their symptoms, or test date if asymptomatic
- UDC will continue to inform families via email on any cases that arise. Families and staff are encouraged to share test results and symptoms with UDC for tracking purposes
